



IWC 2025: A Conference for Fiber Artists

Call for Workshop Proposals

Conference Dates: 17 - 21 June 2025

Albuquerque Convention Center, Albuquerque NM

Workshops and Seminars Requested

IWC is seeking proposals for the following workshops and seminars:

- 3-hour seminars – 3 hours for a half day. Participants should be required to bring minimal supplies.
- 1-day workshops – 6 hours total for one day. Small equipment such as inkle looms and marudai/kumihimo disks can be required, but no table, floor or rigid heddle looms.
- 3-day workshops – 6 hours total for each day, 18 hours total for 3 days

The 3-day workshops will be held Wednesday through Friday, 18-20 June 2025.

The 3-hour seminars and 1-day workshops will be held on Saturday, 21 June 2025.

IWC is encouraging leaders that propose a 3-day workshop to also propose 1-day workshops or two 3-hour seminars. The subject matter for 3-day workshops and 1-day workshops or seminars should be different.

Leader Compensation

Honoraria will be paid at a rate of \$600 per day of instruction, or \$300 per 3-hour seminar.

Travel will be reimbursed for instructors that teach a minimum of six hours and reside 60 miles or more from the conference site. Travel will be reimbursed at a maximum of \$100 for every three hours of instruction not to exceed \$700 or the actual cost of the travel, whichever is less. If driving, compensation will be paid at \$.50 per mile up to the maximum travel reimbursement.

Materials shipment will be reimbursed a maximum of \$50 for 3-day workshops only.

Hotel compensation will be paid directly by IWC and will be provided at half the cost of a double room at the blocked room rate at the IWC hotel under the following schedule:

3-day workshop: 4 nights

3-day workshop plus 1-day workshop or 2 half-day seminars: 5 nights

1 day workshop or 2 half-day seminars: 2 nights

Meals and/or per diem for meals will be provided for instructors that teach a minimum of 6 hours per day on the days they are teaching.

Equipment needed for the workshop must be specified in the proposal. IWC will do their best to provide requested equipment but cannot guarantee they can provide the requested equipment. IWC will provide a TV for showing a portable computer screen if requested. The instructor will need to provide the portable computer and any needed cables/software.

IWC requires Leaders to accept a minimum of 12 students per session, however, IWC reserves the right to run a session should enrollment fall below 12.

Proposal Format

To submit a proposal, fill out the PDF fillable form. Email the completed proposal form along with references and digital images of your work.

All the information should be emailed to Sandra Corp, at the email address, and must be received by February 28, 2024, Workshop selections will be completed by the end of March 2024.
