Information for Vendors

The IWC Market will again be an important part of the Intermountain Weavers Conference (www.intermountainweavers.org) at Fort Lewis College, 1000 Rim Drive, Durango, CO 81301. The Market will be located in the Student Union Ballroom during the July 22-25, 2021 conference.

Booth Dimensions and Fees: Booth spaces are 10 ft. x 10 ft. at **\$125** each. One table 8 ft. x 4 ft. and two chairs per booth are provided. (The number of chairs for multiple booths will be adjusted according to your needs.) Pole and drape to separate booths are also provided. Additional tables can be rented for **\$10** per table, or you may bring your own.

Important Dates:

1 May 2021. Last day to register for an IWC Market booth and be listed in the Conference booklet.

1 June 2021. Last day to register for an IWC Market booth (vendor will not be listed in the Conference booklet).

Application Process: You can apply online, or print out and complete the attached 2021 Vendor Application form and mail to the address below. The preferred method is to apply online. Registration will not be considered complete until we have received payment. The online registration is at the following web page:

Booth Assignments: Booth assignments will be made on a first-come, first-serve basis, determined by registration date. Final space assignments will be made at the discretion of IWC.

Cancellation Policy: If you find that you will be unable to attend, on written request, IWC will refund 50% of fees for cancellations between March 1 and May 1, 2021. **No refunds will be given after May 1, 2021.**

Market Hours: Market hours are **tentatively** set to coincide with times when registrants are free to shop: Thursday 1:00 – 6:00 PM, Friday 11 AM – 8:00 PM, and Saturday 11 AM – 6:00 PM. Hours are longer on Friday to allow the public and conference participants who are not in class time to shop. There will be local advertising to attract the general public.

Events and Workshops: We invite vendors to join us for IWC activities such as the Keynote Address, Exhibits, and Fashion Show. Vendors may participate in our 1- and 3-day workshops, provided they are confident that their booth will be covered in their absence. 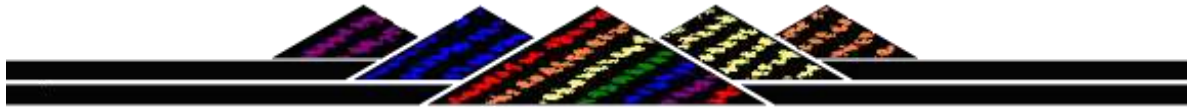
