IWC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Eligibility

Scholarships are available for anyone interested in developing or advancing their knowledge and skills in the fiber arts area, no matter their skill level. The IWC Board is particularly interested in providing scholarships to beginning and emerging artists. Scholarship will cover the full conference registration fee. Class material fee is not covered. Food other than that included in the registration fee will not be covered. Lodging and travel expenses will not be covered. Previous IWC Scholarship recipients are not eligible. Scholarship recipients must be current members of IWC. Membership is \$25.00 for a 2-year period. Application Process

Interested individuals shall submit their written application for a scholarship to the Scholarship Committee prior to submitting their registration for the conference. Do not send your application with your conference registration. To assure attendance in the workshop of your choice your application must be postmarked no later than January 1, 2023.

Sections 1-4:

The scholarship application form must be completely filled out. Please include your name, address, telephone number(s), and email address. Please use the back of the application or attach additional sheets in filling out sections 2 through 4.

Section 5:

The written recommendation can be from a member of IWC, someone from a local fiber guild, or other fiber artist, teacher, or mentor who knows the applicant and is familiar with his/her work. Recommendation should also include how he/she knows you, what kind of fiber art you do, and his/her judgment regarding your skill level and your potential as a fiber artist.
