IWC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Eligibility

Scholarships are available for anyone interested in developing or advancing their knowledge and skills in the fiber arts area, no matter their skill level. The IWC Board is particularly interested in providing scholarships to beginning and emerging artists. Scholarship will cover the full conference registration fee. Class material fee is not covered. Food other than that included in the registration fee will not be covered. Lodging and travel expenses will not be covered. Previous IWC Scholarship recipients are not eligible. Scholarship applicants must be current members of IWC. Membership is \$25.00 for a 2-year period. You may sign up for an IWC membership on the IWC website, www.intermountainweavers.org.

Application Process

The application for a scholarship must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than 7 Dec 2024. Applicants will be informed if they have received the scholarship on 18 Dec 2024.

Sections 1-4:

The scholarship application form must be completely filled out. Please include your name, address, telephone number(s), and email address. Please use the back of the application or attach additional sheets in filling out sections 2 through 4.

Section 5:

The recommendation can be from a member of IWC, someone from a local fiber guild, or other fiber artist, teacher, or mentor who knows the applicant and is familiar with his/her work. Recommendation should also include how he/she knows you, what kind of fiber art you do, and his/her judgment regarding your skill level and your potential as a fiber artist.
