**The qualifications of the artist/instructor**, especially in two areas: professional participation in the field and experience teaching adults.

The workshop/seminar itself: IWC offers workshop/seminars in fiber arts with an emphasis on weaving, spinning, dyeing, knitting, basketry, felting, and surface design. We are interested in workshop/seminars with a strong connection between the artist's creative work and the workshop/seminar. We hope that artists can use IWC to try new approaches in their teaching. We serve a broad audience: professionals and "near-professionals," art educators, and people who may make their livings in non-arts occupations, but who, nevertheless, are seriously interested in improving their skills.

**Workshop/seminar considerations:** we look for workshop/seminars which will be effective in a short-term, intensive format. We try to avoid situations where our workshop/seminars compete directly with each other.
